Tine De Moor, Ph.D., is a Professor at the Rotterdam School of Management, Erasmus University (RSM), where she holds the Chair in Institutions for Collective Action. She is also a core member of the Erasmus Research Institute of Management (ERIM).

She has held teaching and research positions at several prestigious institutions, including Ghent University (Belgium), Utrecht University (Netherlands), the London School of Economics and Political Science (UK), and the University of Oxford (UK). She is a co-founder of the internationally recognized journal *International Journal of the Commons* and has served as President of the International Association for the Study of the Commons (IASC).

Professor De Moor's research is highly interdisciplinary, with a focus on **social enterprises, commons governance, institutional evolution, and mechanisms of collective action**. She has led several major research projects funded by the **European Research Council (ERC)** and the **Dutch Research Council (NWO)**. Her work is widely published by leading academic publishers such as *Cambridge University Press*, *Oxford University Press*, and in top-tier international journals.
